Fresh / purified air

16C (sat down) / 13C (severe physical effort) – not producing harmful fumes – thermometers

Suitable/sufficient, natural if possible – emergency backup for artificial

Not allowing waste material to accumulate, must be in suitable containers

Furniture, furnishing & fittings kept clean

Surfaces, walls, floors, ceilings cleaned

- Drinking water
- Rest facilities

In isolation from other workers – violence, accident/illness, access/egress, hazards, machinery, vulnerabilities - Supervision

Oxygen deficient / limited means of access / emergency procedures
